

How to deal with author-PDFs

Publication of manuscripts by authors

Definition:

A "*manuscript*" is the non-appraised version of the article.

Use of manuscripts by authors:

Prior to publication the authors can publish a manuscript version of their article on their employer's website.

Preprint publication by authors

Definition:

A "*preprint*" is the final draft of the manuscript as accepted for publication. It contains the changes on the basis of suggestions by the appraiser, but has not yet been edited by the publisher and does not contain any bibliographic data.

Preprint use by authors:

The authors can publish a preprint version of the article on their employer's website. However, the publisher only allows this if the following reference is made to GJAE:

The article will appear / has been published in: GJAE No. x, dated xx.xx.201x

Self-archiving of original articles

36 months after publication in GJAE or formerly AGRARWIRTSCHAFT authors can publish a PDF of the original article on their employer's website too. However, the publisher only allows this if the following reference is

made to GJAE:

The article appeared in: GJAE No. x, dated xx.xx.201x, S. xx-xx

Presentation of preprint publication or self-archiving

In both cases the PDF must be provided with the GJAE/AGRARWIRTSCHAFT logo and the reference "Autoren-Exemplar / Author's Personal Copy".
