

# Call for Editors for the German Journal of Agricultural Economics (GJAE)

The Editorial Team of the German Journal of Agricultural Economics (GJAE) is looking for two new members to serve as editors starting April 2024 and January 2025 for a period of three years with the possibility of an extension. The new members are to succeed two of the current editors, Sebastian Hess and Martin Odening. Candidates should be well connected in the agricultural socio-economic community, and have interest and experience in publishing scientific articles. Expertise in peer review and experience as a member of the Editorial Board of a scientific journal are an advantage.

The Editors advance and implement the concept of the GJAE as an Open Access Journal, together with the editorial team to communicate high-quality agricultural socio-economic research to a broad, primarily scientific readership. Teamwork and efficient deadline management are essential.

# Profile of the German Journal of Agricultural Economics

The GJAE is a scientific journal that publishes peer-reviewed research articles. The journal is currently published four times a year in an online format. It is aimed at people interested in basic and applied research in the field of agricultural and food economics and related disciplines.

# Tasks of the editors

The main task of the editors can be summarised as follows:

- Coordination of the review of submitted articles manuscripts to ensure high scientific quality and readability
- Advice and support for authors with any necessary revisions to submissions
- Assistance in identifying topics and motivating potential authors to submit relevant contributions
- Participation and involvement in the meetings of the Editorial Board

The GJAE Editorial support team provides technical and production services from acceptance of the manuscript to publication. Almost all communication within the Editorial team and between authors, reviewers takes place digitally.

### Remuneration of the co-editors

Membership in the Editorial Team is voluntary and unpaid.
